

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
K STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT**

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Shelton until 1:30 p.m. on **February 6, 2012**, at which time bids will be publicly opened for the project listed above. The project involves cold milling and overlaying 1 to 2 inches of the asphalt on K Street, from the intersection with Olympic Highway (Project Station 0+30±) to North 13th Street (Project Station 27+87±). The proposed project may also include a number of localized (or regional) full depth repairs to the road structure that require a geosynthetic for materials separation in the areas of existing sub-grade or base coarse failure (as identified during construction by the City's on-site engineering representative); and the utilization of an geosynthetic fabric within the asphalt overlay for the length of the project. The Project will also include replacing the sidewalk on the south side of the road and the existing sidewalk ramps with ramps that meet current ADA standards.
