Legend of the Survey of David Shelton's 2<sup>nd</sup> addition to the Town of Sheltonville. Beginning at the NE Cor of block (A) 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition to the Town of Sheltonville; Run N 7° 30' East 60 feet and established a corner said corner being the S East Corner of block No 1, and the initial point to David Shelton's 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition to the Town of Sheltonville. Said corner 2 1/2 inches in diameter set 14 in. on ground. Variation of all lines of streets and alleys N 1° 30' East or S 7° 30' West. Streets 60 feet wide. Excepting R R Avenue which is 100 feet wide. Alleys 20 feet wide.
